T E R M S AND CONDITIONS

Eligibility

1. The competition is open to residents of England, Wales and Scotland.
2. Entrants must be 18 years old or over and own a pet. In entering the competition, you confirm that you are eligible to do so. The Promoter may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the competition.

The Competition

4. The competition begins on 1st September 2020 and closes at midday on 30th October 2020 (the "Closing Date").
5. There will be one category winner from each of the 10 categories and one overall Best in Show
6. By entering this competition all entrants will be deemed to have accepted and be bound by these terms and conditions. All entry instructions form part of these terms and conditions.

Entry

7. To enter, entrants must complete the online registration form, providing full name, a valid email address, telephone number and upload a photograph of your pet relating to each of the categories you wish to enter.
8. The entries will be judged after the Closing Date by an independent judge based on the entry which most aptly and passionately captures the pet's spirit for their chosen category. The decision of the independent judge (acting reasonably) will be final.
9. You agree that the Promoter may, but is not required to, make your entry available on its website and any other media. You agree to grant the Promoter a nonexclusive, worldwide, irrevocable licence, for the full period of any intellectual property rights in the competition entry and any accompanying materials, to use, display, publish, transmit, copy, edit, alter, store, re-format and sub-licence the competition entry and any accompanying materials for such purposes.
10. Entry fees are £5 per category entered.

Prize

11. All entrants will receive a certificate of entry
12. Winners will receive Butterwick Best in Show winning rosettes

13. The Promoter does not accept any responsibility if any prize winner is not able to take up the prize.

14. The Promoter reserves the right to publicise the winning entrants name and photograph on the Promoter's website to announce the winner of this competition and for any other reasonable and related promotional purposes and you agree to participate in any reasonable publicity required by the Promoter

15. Spot prizes will be given throughout the competition, if and when available. Spot prizes will be announced on the Promoters website and other media throughout the competition.

16. All unsuccessful entries will not be published, but all those taking part will receive a certificate of entry.

17. In the event of unforeseen circumstances the Promoter reserves the right to provide alternative prizes of equal or greater value.

Winner Announcement

18. The prize winner will be notified within fourteen (14) days of the Closing Date to the email address submitted by the prize winner. To claim the prize, each prize winner must within 48 hours of notification from the Promoter confirm acceptance of the prize.

19. If the Promoter is unable to contact the prize winner or if the prize winner does not confirm acceptance of the prize, the Promoter reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the remaining entries that were received before the Closing Date.

20. In all cases the Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. No cash alternative will be offered in whole or in part.

21. The Promoter reserves the right not to award a prize (and to select an alternative winner) if the Promoter is aware or has reasonable grounds to believe that a winner is not eligible.

General

22. The Promoter accepts no liability or responsibility for entries lost, delayed or undelivered, nor any liability for technical errors or communication failures in networks and/or internet access. It is the responsibility of the entrant when entering the competition to provide the correct information on the entry form.
